Over the last decades, key health indicators such as life expectancy and coverage of immunization have improved notably, whilst infant mortality, maternal mortality and fertility rates have dropped significantly. Long before the emergence of contemporary global health initiatives, the government placed strong emphasis on the importance of childhood immunization as a key mechanism for reducing childhood mortality. Expanded Programme on Immunisation (EPI) in Bangladesh is considered to be a health system success because of its remarkable progress over the last two decades. It provides almost universal access to vaccination services, as measured by the percentage of children under 1 year of age who receive BCG (a vaccine against tuberculosis). This increased from 2% in 1985 to 99% in 2009. Coverage of other vaccines has also improved substantially.

Bangladesh's economy is projected to grow 6.9 per cent in fiscal year 2022-23 thanks to strong export growth and a rebound in domestic demand, the World Bank (WB) said in its Global Economic Prospects released. Dhaka and Chittagong are the principal financial centers of the country, being home to the Dhaka Stock Exchange and the Chittagong Stock Exchange. The financial sector of Bangladesh is the second largest in the subcontinent. Bangladesh is one of the world's fastest growing economy. The country has pursued export-oriented industrialization. It has also developed self-sufficient industries in pharmaceuticals, steel and food processing. Over the last 50 years since independence Bangladesh has made lot of strides in the Health Sector. Visibly there is proliferation in health infrastructures - medical colleges, medical university, private medical colleges, private clinics, private hospitals, district hospital, rural health centers and community clinics.

INDUSTRIES SECTOR RECORD BREAKING GDP GROWTH

Pharmaceuticals industry of Bangladesh has grown significantly over the last five years. From 2012 to 2017, historical five years CAGR was 15% and from 2014 to 2017, historical three years CAGR was 21%. According to industry experts, market size of pharmaceuticals may reach about BDT 330,000 million by 2024.

Improved healthcare facilities and diagnosis with modern technology and rapid growth of chronic diseases due to change in lifestyle and environment factors are other reasons for the growth of domestic drug market, Shafiuzzaman mentions. According to Export Promotion Bureau (EPB) data, Bangladesh's medicine exports registered a 25.60% rise to \$130 million in FY19, which was \$103.46 million the previous year. Beximco Pharma, a leading exporters to the US, has received US FDA certification, while Square Pharmaceuticals and Incepta got UK MHRA (Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency) certification to exports items.

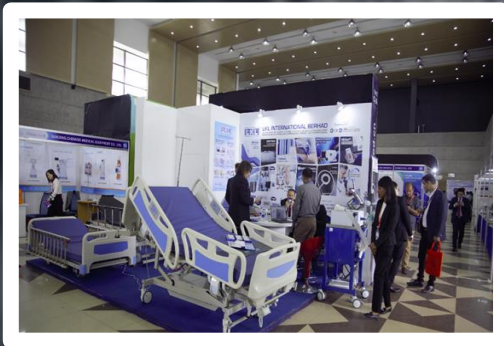
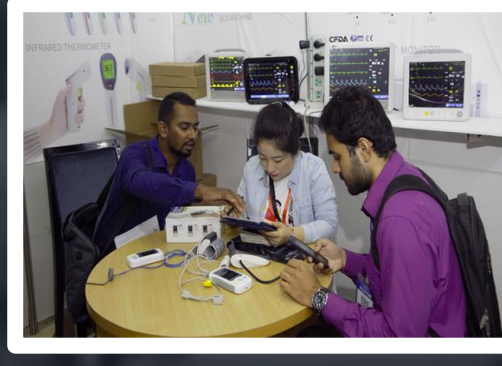
